Minimum Measure #1 - Public Education

Possible Activities: Storm water-related articles in newsletter and/or web site; stormwater programs aired on local cable channel, storm drain labeling, posting stream crossing signs, distribution of educational fact sheets, participation in East Fork watershed activities
